



Wave Radio New Volunteer Positions

Dr Gray's Hospital Broadcasting Service (Wave Radio) is a community and hospital radio station based in Dr Gray's Hospital in Elgin. We broadcast within the hospital on an internal loop and to the Moray Community (and the rest of the world) as an internet radio station. The Station broadcasts 24hrs a day 365 days a year using a mixture of pre-recorded and live programming. Wave Radio is a voluntary service which receives no funding from the NHS. All monies for the running of the station are raised by fundraising and donations.

To help Wave Radio continue and to grow we are looking to fill the following voluntary positions:

Fundraising/Sales Person

Wave Radio is looking for a Fundraising/Sales person. The position is voluntary and requires ideally between 2 and 3 hours per week either in one day or spread over several days (although this can be flexible and may be a few hours per month).

The position will entail writing to and visiting local businesses to obtain sponsorship for individual radio shows, selling radio adverts and website adverts. There will be no targets and guidance as to what is required will be given. You will be working from home and from our Studio.

A background in sales and marketing would be ideal but enthusiasm and personality would go a long way. The position would suit anyone who has time to spare either a retired sales person or someone who is friendly and interested in meeting people.

The position requires that you will be able to work on your own initiative and you will report directly to the Chairman.

Wave Radio is looking for one or two people to carry out research for presenters to bring local content to our programming. The position is voluntary and requires ideally between 2 and 3 hours per week working from both home and our Studio.

The position will entail researching local information (e.g news & events) and people. Also arranging interviews for presenters.

An interest in meeting people, enthusiasm and personality are essential, along with the ability to work on your own initiative. You will work alongside our Programme Controller to establish what and when the required information is at any given time.
